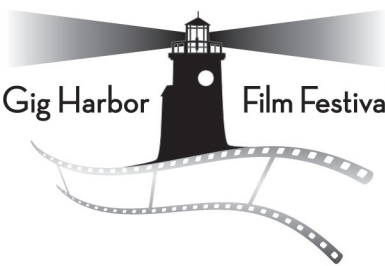

Once fully formed and dried, each piece is fired at 1,800 degrees, transforming it into a durable ceramic work of art ready for finishing and display.

Known as one of the most recognizable coastal birds, seagulls are found around the world, from Arctic shores to tropical islands – always in motion, always alive with energy. This sculpture beautifully reflects that universal presence and seaside freedom.
